01 Spare

02 You shall keep the peace, be of good behaviour and appear before the Court when required to do so.

03 In this Peace Bond, the term "bail supervisor" refers to an adult Probation officer or an adult Bail Supervisor and includes his or her designate. You shall report in person to a Bail Supervisor within \_\_\_\_\_ working day(s) of signing this Peace Bond. Thereafter you shall report to your Supervisor as required by, and in the manner directed by your Supervisor.

04 You shall promptly notify the Court, in advance, of any change of your name, address, or, employment or occupation.

05 You shall remain within the province of Alberta unless you have written permission from the Court to leave the province of Alberta.

06 You shall surrender your passport or other travel documents to the Clerk of the Provincial Court of Alberta within 24 hours of release, and shall not possess a valid passport issued by any country, and, shall not apply for, or renew, a passport issued by any country.

07 You shall reside at \_\_\_\_\_ or such address for which you have the written approval from the Court, and shall not change that address without the prior written consent of the Court.

08 You shall observe a curfew and remain in your approved residence between the hours of:

and you shall not otherwise be outside your approved residence unless you have prior written permission from your Supervisor or the Court. You shall be available to answer

the phone, and to present yourself at the door to a Supervisor or Peace Officer who attends to verify compliance with the term.

09 You shall seek or maintain employment or education or training and provide proof of attendance at your place of employment or education or training (including any schedule) to your Supervisor and, you shall advise your Supervisor in writing of the name, address and telephone number of your employer.

11 You shall attend for such assessment, counselling or treatment as the Court is now directing or as may be directed by your Supervisor or approved by the Province of Alberta, including:

A Psychiatric/psychological counselling.

B Alcohol/drug abuse.

C Financial counselling.

D Domestic violence treatment program.

E Anger management.

F Marital/parenting.

G Gambling addiction.

H Enrol in/reside at the \_\_\_\_\_ program and abide by its rules.

and you shall provide satisfactory written proof of attendance to your Supervisor, and, you shall complete program(s) by the date specified in writing by your Supervisor and provide satisfactory written proof of such completion by the date requested in writing by your Supervisor.

14 You shall refrain from the purchase, possession, use or consumption of alcohol, other intoxicating substances, or any non-prescribed controlled substance within the meaning of the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act. You shall not permit any of these substances in your residence.

15 Having advised this Court, personally or through counsel, that you agree to provide samples of your breath, urine or blood in order to monitor compliance with a direction that you refrain from using or consuming alcohol, other intoxicating substances, or any non-prescribed controlled substance within the meaning of the Controlled Drugs and

Substances Act, if your Supervisor or a Peace Officer has reasonable grounds to believe that you have failed to comply with such direction, you shall supply on demand, to your Supervisor or a Peace Officer, a sample of your breath, urine or blood.

16 You shall not be in any licensed premises other than a dining room for the sole purpose of having a meal.

17 You shall have no contact or communication whatsoever, either directly or indirectly, with

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- A except to arrange access to your children (or stepchildren) through a third party or by Court Order,
  - B except as may be specifically approved of in advance in writing by the Court,
  - C except by phone or in the presence of a mutually agreed upon third party or in a public place.

18 You shall not attend at, or within a \_\_\_\_\_ block radius of, the address(s) or location described as:

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19 You may return to the address \_\_\_\_\_ on one (1) occasion only, in order to retrieve personal property, but only if accompanied by police or a mutually agreed upon third party, on a date and time agreed upon by the lawful occupant thereof through the Victim's Advocate, or through counsel.

20 You shall not be in possession of any firearm, firearms licence, authorization or registration certificate related to the possession of firearms, crossbow, prohibited weapon, restricted weapon, prohibited device, ammunition, prohibited ammunition, or explosive substance, as defined in the Criminal Code. All items that you are hereby prohibited from possessing shall be surrendered to the Edmonton Police Service no later than the date of \_\_\_\_\_. Additionally, all such items shall be forfeited to the Crown in right of Alberta unless otherwise ordered by a Court.

21 You shall not possess a cell phone, pager, paging device, portable telecommunication device, or any other electronic device (including but not limited to a Blackberry or similar device or a radio scanner, whether operable or not) that is capable of sending or receiving electronic messages of any kind. If, for a legitimate purpose, you require a cell phone, paging device, portable telecommunication device, or, other electronic device capable of sending or receiving electronic messages, the Court may allow limited use of same at its discretion. You must provide the Court with a letter from the institution or employer outlining the nature of work and the required use of the device. You may only use the device for the purpose for which permission has been granted and only during the hours to verify your legitimate need of any device. You may only use the device for the purpose for which permission has been granted and only during the hours specified by the Court, and, you must provide a copy of the monthly bill and log sheets for the device to the Court.

22 Spare

23 Other than a motor vehicle properly registered in your name, you are prohibited from operating, or being in, any motor vehicle on any street, road, highway or other public place unless you have the written permission of the registered owner of that vehicle (or the registered owner of that vehicle is present in the vehicle with you), or, as a passenger in a taxi or another licensed form of fare-charging public transportation.

24 You shall not be in possession of any identification documents, credit cards, debit cards or mail, except that which is lawfully in your name or addressed to you.
