Residence

- (b) RESIDE AT (1) _____ OR (2) AT AN ADDRESS FOR WHICH YOU HAVE PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM YOUR PROBATION OFFICER & YOU SHALL NOT CHANGE THAT RESIDENCE WITHOUT THE PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL OF YOUR PROBATION OFFICER;

- (c) REMAIN WITHIN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA UNLESS PRIOR WRITTEN PERMISSION TO LEAVE THE PROVINCE IS OBTAINED FROM THE COURT OR YOUR PROBATION OFFICER;

Passport

- (d) YOU SHALL IMMEDIATELY SURRENDER TO YOUR PROBATION OFFICER ANY PASSPORT THAT HAS BEEN ISSUED TO YOU & SHALL NOT POSSESS A PASSPORT ISSUED BY ANY COUNTRY NOR APPLY FOR OR RENEW A PASSPORT FROM ANY COUNTRY.

Employment

- (e) YOU SHALL SEEK OR MAINTAIN EMPLOYMENT, EDUCATION OR TRAINING AND PROVIDE YOUR PROBATION OFFICER WITH PROOF OF ATTENDANCE AT YOUR

PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT, EDUCATION OR TRAINING (INCLUDING YOUR WORK AND TRAINING SCHEDULE), AND YOU SHALL ADVISE YOUR PROBATION OFFICER IN WRITING OF THE ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF YOUR EMPLOYER, EDUCATIONAL OR TRAINING FACILITY.

Physician's Care

- (h) YOU SHALL REMAIN UNDER THE CARE OF A MEDICAL PHYSICIAN OR THE PHYSICIAN'S DELEGATE OR A PHARMACIST & FOLLOW THEIR INSTRUCTIONS, INCLUDING THE TAKING OF PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION ONLY IN THE MANNER & AMOUNT PRESCRIBED.

Drug & Alcohol Prohibition

- (j) HAVING ADVISED THIS COURT, PERSONALLY OR THROUGH COUNSEL, THAT YOU AGREE TO PROVIDE SAMPLES OF YOUR BREATH, URINE OR BLOOD IN ORDER TO MONITOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE ABSTINENCE CLAUSE ABOVE, YOU SHALL SUPPLY ON DEMAND, TO YOUR PROBATION OFFICER OR A PEACE OFFICER, A SAMPLE OF YOUR BREATH, URINE OR BLOOD, IF YOUR PROBATION OFFICER OR A PEACE OFFICER REASONABLY SUSPECTS THAT YOU HAVE FAILED TO COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (i) OR FOR THE PURPOSES OF RANDOM TESTING.
- (k) YOU SHALL NOT ENTER OR BE FOUND IN ANY PREMISES WHOSE PRIMARY PURPOSE IS GAMBLING OR THE RETAIL SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Community Service Work

- (m) YOU SHALL NOT HAVE ANY CONTACT OR COMMUNICATION, EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY WITH ANY PERSON NAMED IN WRITING BY YOUR PROBATION

- (i) EXCEPT TO ARRANGE ACCESS TO YOUR DEPENDENT CHILDREN THROUGH A THIRD PARTY OR BY COURT ORDER; OR
- (ii) EXCEPT IN THE MANNER AS MAY BE SPECIFICALLY APPROVED OF IN ADVANCE IN WRITING BY YOUR PROBATION OFFICER.

- (n) YOU SHALL NOT ATTEND AT, OR WITHIN A _____ BLOCK RADIUS OF, THE ADDRESS(ES) OR LOCATION DESCRIBED AS _____ EXCEPT WITH THE PRIOR WRITTEN PERMISSION OF YOUR PROBATION OFFICER.

- (t) OBSERVE A CURFEW & REMAIN IN YOUR RESIDENCE BETWEEN _____ P.M. TO _____ A.M. EVERYDAY EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:
 - (i) TO ATTEND AT AN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION TO TAKE COURSES OR TRAINING APPROVED BY YOUR PROBATION OFFICER;
 - (ii) TO ATTEND AT YOUR PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT, OR AT ANY OTHER PLACE WHERE YOU ARE SEEKING EMPLOYMENT;
 - (iii) TO PERFORM ANY COMMUNITY SERVICE OBLIGATIONS;
 - (iv) TO ATTEND APPOINTMENTS WITH YOUR LAWYER, OR ATTEND COURT AS REQUIRED BY LAW;
 - (v) TO ATTEND FOR MEDICAL, DENTAL OR HEALTH APPOINTMENTS FOR YOURSELF, SPOUSE/PARTNER, OR DEPENDENT CHILDREN RESIDING WITH YOU AT YOUR APPROVED RESIDENCE;
 - (vi) TO ATTEND FOR ANY ASSESSMENT, TREATMENT OR COUNSELING AS DIRECTED BY THE COURT OR DIRECTED OR APPROVED BY YOUR PROBATION OFFICER;
 - (vii) TO SHOP FOR THE NECESSITIES OF LIFE, WHICH CUMULATIVELY SHALL NOT EXCEED _____ HOURS PER WEEK;
 - (viii) TO PARTICIPATE IN SUCH OTHER PROGRAMS OR SERVICES DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY YOUR PROBATION OFFICER;
 - (ix) FOR RELIGIOUS SERVICES OR NATIVE CULTURAL CEREMONIES;
 - (x) TO REPORT TO YOUR PROBATION OFFICER;
 - (xi) TO VOTE IN A MUNICIPAL, PROVINCIAL OR FEDERAL ELECTION; OR

EXCEPTION: PRIOR APPROVAL IS NOT REQUIRED IF YOU, OR YOUR SPOUSE/PARTNER, OR A DEPENDENT CHILD RESIDING WITH YOU AT YOUR RESIDENCE, REQUIRE EMERGENCY MEDICAL OR DENTAL TREATMENT. IN THE EVENT OF SUCH EMERGENCY, YOU SHALL GO DIRECTLY TO THE NEAREST MEDICAL FACILITY & YOU SHALL RETURN TO YOUR RESIDENCE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AND IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY YOUR PROBATION OFFICER OF YOUR ABSENCE, THE LOCATION YOU ATTENDED, AND THE SPECIFIC REASONS FOR THE ABSENCE. YOU SHALL PROVIDE TO YOUR PROBATION OFFICER SATISFACTORY PROOF OF THE EMERGENCY TREATMENT.

AT ALL TIMES WHEN YOU ARE ABSENT FROM YOUR RESIDENCE, YOU SHALL CARRY A LEGIBLE COPY OF THIS ORDER, INCLUDING ANY AMENDMENTS & ANY WRITTEN APPROVALS SIGNED BY YOUR PROBATION OFFICER.

YOU SHALL PRODUCE THESE DOCUMENTS TO ANY PEACE OFFICER OR PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OR SUPERVISION OF THIS ORDER UPON REQUEST.

Enforcement
Of Curfew

- (u) VERIFICATION
DURING THE PERIOD OF TIME THAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN YOUR RESIDENCE WHILE UNDER A CURFEW:
- (i) YOU SHALL PHYSICALLY PRESENT YOURSELF TO YOUR PROBATION OFFICER OR TO ANY PEACE OFFICER WHO ATTENDS AT YOUR RESIDENCE; AND
- (ii) YOU SHALL SPEAK TO YOUR PROBATION OFFICER ON THE TELEPHONE WHENEVER YOUR PROBATION OFFICER TELEPHONES YOUR RESIDENCE. THIS TELEPHONE NUMBER MUST NOT UTILIZE A CALL TRANSFER SERVICE & YOU MUST RESTRICT THE USE OF THE TELEPHONE LINE TO 15 MINUTES OF CONSECUTIVE USE OR LESS SO THAT YOUR PROBATION OFFICER CAN CONTACT YOU.

Pornography
Restriction

- (v) YOU SHALL NOT POSSESS ANY CHILD PORNOGRAPHY AND YOU SHALL NOT POSSESS ANY ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, COMPUTER OR COMPUTER SOFTWARE THAT HAS THE CAPABILITY OF STORING OR VIEWING CHILD PORNOGRAPHY.
- (w) YOU SHALL PROVIDE REASONABLE ACCESS TO YOUR RESIDENCE DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS TO YOUR PROBATION OFFICER OR ANY PEACE OFFICER WHO SEEKS ENTRY IN ORDER TO VIEW THE INTERIOR OF THE RESIDENCE AND DO ALL NECESSARY THINGS IN ORDER TO DETERMINE THE PRESENCE OF ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, COMPUTER OR COMPUTER SOFTWARE THAT IS CAPABLE OF STORING OR VIEWING CHILD PORNOGRAPHY.

Drug
Paraphernalia

- (x) YOU SHALL PROVIDE REASONABLE ACCESS TO YOUR RESIDENCE DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS TO YOUR PROBATION OFFICER OR ANY PEACE OFFICER WHO SEEKS ENTRY TO VIEW THE INTERIOR OF THE RESIDENCE FOR THE PRESENCE OF ALCOHOL OR ANY SUBSTANCE PROHIBITED BY THE CONTROLLED DRUGS AND SUBSTANCES ACT.
- (y) YOU SHALL NOT POSSESS ANY EQUIPMENT, SUBSTANCES, CHEMICALS OR INGREDIENTS ASSOCIATED IN THE GROWING OR PRODUCTION OF ILLICIT DRUGS.

Cellular
Telephone

- (z) YOU SHALL NOT POSSESS ANY CELLULAR TELEPHONE, PAGING DEVICE, PORTABLE TELECOMMUNICATION DEVICE OR ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICE (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO BLACKBERRY OR SIMILAR DEVICE), OR A RADIO SCANNER THAT IS CAPABLE OF SENDING OR RECEIVING ELECTRONIC MESSAGES OF ANY KIND WITHOUT THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF YOUR PROBATION OFFICER & FOR PURPOSES PERMITTED BY YOUR PROBATION OFFICER.

Underage
Restriction

- (aa) YOU SHALL NOT HAVE ANY CONTACT OR COMMUNICATION EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY WITH ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF _____ (16/18 YEARS) UNLESS YOU ARE IN THE IMMEDIATE PRESENCE OF AN ADULT GUARDIAN OR PARENT OF SUCH CHILD.
- (bb) YOU SHALL REFRAIN FROM BEING PRESENT IN (OR WITHIN 100 METERS OF) ANY PUBLIC PARK, PUBLIC SWIMMING AREA, DAYCARE CENTRE, SCHOOL GROUND, PLAYGROUND OR COMMUNITY CENTRE WHERE ONE MIGHT REASONABLY EXPECT CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF _____ (16/18) YEARS TO BE PRESENT.
- (cc) YOU ARE PROHIBITED FROM SEEKING, OBTAINING OR CONTINUING ANY EMPLOYMENT, WHETHER OR NOT THE EMPLOYMENT IS REMUNERATED, OR BECOMING OR BEING A VOLUNTEER IN A CAPACITY THAT INVOLVES BEING IN A POSITION OF TRUST OR AUTHORITY TOWARD ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF _____ (16/18) YEARS.

Motor Vehicle
Restriction

- (dd) OTHER THAN A MOTOR VEHICLE PROPERLY REGISTERED IN YOUR NAME, YOU ARE PROHIBITED FROM OPERATING, OR BEING IN, ANY MOTOR VEHICLE ON ANY STREET, ROAD, HIGHWAY OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACE UNLESS YOU HAVE THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE REGISTERED OWNER OF THAT VEHICLE (OR THE REGISTERED OWNER OF THAT VEHICLE IS PRESENT IN THE VEHICLE WITH YOU), OR, AS A PASSENGER IN A TAXI OR ANOTHER LICENSED FORM OF FARE-CHARGING PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION.
- (ee) OTHER TERMS _____

4. EXEMPTION

WHERE APPROPRIATE YOUR PROBATION OFFICER MAY GRANT TEMPORARY WRITTEN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OF THE TERMS OF THIS ORDER, PROVIDED THAT THE EXEMPTION IS FOR THE PURPOSES OF ADDRESSING AN IMMEDIATE NEED WITH RESPECT TO YOUR REHABILITATION OR FOR A HUMANITARIAN PURPOSE.

5. DEFINITIONS

IN THIS ORDER:

- (a) "RESIDENCE" MEANS THAT RESIDENCE WHICH HAS BEEN DESIGNATED BY THE COURT OR APPROVED BY YOUR PROBATION OFFICER FROM TIME TO TIME;
- (b) "CURFEW" MEANS THAT PERIOD OF TIME WHEN YOU ARE REQUIRED TO REMAIN WITHIN YOUR APPROVED RESIDENCE AS SET OUT IN THIS ORDER;
- (c) "HOUSE ARREST" MEANS THAT PERIOD OF TIME WHEN YOU ARE REQUIRED TO REMAIN WITHIN YOUR APPROVED RESIDENCE AS SET OUT IN THIS ORDER; AND
- (d) "PROBATION OFFICER" MEANS A PERSON EMPLOYED OR ENGAGED UNDER THE CORRECTIONS ACT OF ALBERTA EITHER ON A FULL TIME OR PART TIME BASIS IN THE PERFORMANCE OF DUTIES RELATED TO PROBATION OR MATTERS OF A LIKE NATURE.
