1. You shall keep the peace and be of good behavior.
2. You shall appear before the court when the court requires you to do so.
3. You shall notify the court or the probation officer in advance of any change of your name, address or telephone number or numbers and promptly notify the court or the probation officer of any change in your employment or occupation.
4. You shall:
 - a) have no contact or communication in any manner with _____.

Supervision

6. You shall be under the supervision of a probation officer and report to that probation officer:

- a) by _____ am/pm on _____, 20__;
- b) within _____ hours/days of your release from prison;

and after that, you shall report to your probation officer as directed by your probation officer.

7. You shall:

- a) regularly attend school or other place of learning or training and apply yourself to your studies or training and not be late or absent without an adequate reason.

Or

- b) actively search for and maintain employment.

Or

- c) if you are employed, you shall tell your probation officer what your job is, together with the name, address and phone number of your employer or supervisor.

Residence

8. You shall live at a place that is approved by your probation officer and not change it without first getting permission to do so from your probation officer.

9. You shall give your address and all your telephone numbers, including home, cell and work to your probation officer upon demand by him/her.

10. You shall stay in Alberta unless you have written permission to leave from your probation officer before you leave.

Weapons

11. You shall not possess anything that is designed for use as a weapon, or anything that is intended for use as a weapon.

12. You shall not possess firearms, cross-bows, ammunition, explosive substances, or prohibited devices.

C.S.W.

13. You shall do _____ hours of community service work to be completed by _____ at whatever place your probation officer directs, and you shall give written proof of completion of these hours from each placement to your probation officer by _____.

Counselling

14. You shall attend, participate in and complete any assessment or program of guidance, counseling or treatment your probation officer directs you to do, which could be a residential treatment one, relating to:

- a) alcohol abuse or addiction
- b) drug or substance abuse or addiction
- c) gambling abuse or addiction
- d) sexual abuse or deviancy
- e) intimate partner violence
- f) parenting matters
- g) financial matters
- h) psychiatric and/or psychological issues
- i) first nations traditional healing sessions
- j) or any other one that your probation officer deems necessary.

If your probation officer directs you to attend any assessment, treatment or counseling program, you shall give proof of attendance and completion to your probation officer upon demand. You shall sign any release or waiver as directed by your probation officer allowing him/her access to any information needed to assist your supervision.

Restitution

15. You shall pay restitution in the amount of \$_____.

Drug &
Alcohol

16. You shall not possess or drink alcohol.
17. Having told the court that you can stop drinking alcohol, you shall not possess or drink alcohol.
18. You shall only drink or have alcohol in your body while you are inside your home. If you are outside your home, you must be sober and not have any alcohol in your body.
19. You shall not allow or have alcohol in your home.
20. You shall not enter or be in any place whose main purpose is:
- a) the sale of alcoholic beverages
 - b) gambling

21. You shall not possess, or use in any manner, any illegal drugs or prescription drugs not prescribed to you by your doctor or pharmacist, or any equipment or anything else used in the growing, producing or making of any such drug.
22. You shall take prescription drugs only in the amount and manner prescribed by your doctor or pharmacist.
23. You shall not ingest or inhale any form of intoxicant or intoxicating vapours.
24. You shall give a sample of your breath, urine or other bodily substance upon demand by a peace officer, probation officer or their designate who reasonably believes you have been drinking alcohol or using drugs or intoxicating vapours or substances.

Monitoring

25. During the term of this probation order, you shall wear an electronic bracelet to monitor your whereabouts for as long as your probation officer directs, and you shall follow all rules regarding the wearing of it as given to you in writing by your probation officer, and acknowledge receipt of them in writing.

Curfew

26. You shall stay inside your home or its property limits:
- a) as directed in writing by your probation officer.
- Or
- b) every day from ____pm to ____am the next morning.
- Or
- c) each Sunday to Thursday from ____pm to ____am the next morning.
- Or
- d) each Friday and Saturday from ____pm to ____am the next morning.
- Or

27. During the hours you are required to be in your home or property limits, you shall physically present yourself to any peace officer, probation officer or their designate who comes to your home and speak to them by telephone if he/she phones your home asking for you.

Motor Veh.
Restriction

28. You are prohibited from being in any motor vehicle unless:
- a) you are the registered owner of that motor vehicle;
- Or
- b) the registered owner of that motor vehicle is in it with you;
- Or

c) you have the written permission of the registered owner for you to be in that motor vehicle;

Or

d) you are a passenger in a taxi, bus or other form of public transportation.

Electronic
Prohibition

29. You shall not possess or use any electronic or listening device, equipment, computer or related software capable of sending, receiving, storing or viewing messages, transmissions or images of any type, except a _____(device):

- a) for the purpose of _____.
- b) as permitted in writing by your probation officer and carrying a copy of it and producing it on demand.

30. You shall provide reasonable access to your home between 6:00am and 9:00pm to your probation officer or any peace officer who seeks entry in order to view the interior of your home and do all necessary things in order to determine the presence of electronic equipment, computer or computer software that is capable of storing or viewing child pornography.

31. You shall provide reasonable access to your home between 6:00am and 9:00pm to your probation officer or any peace officer who seeks entry to view the interior of your home for the presence of alcohol or any non prescription or illegal drugs, or anything used to grow or make non prescription or illegal drugs.

32. You shall not have any contact or communication in any manner with any person under the age of _____(16/18) years unless you are in the immediate presence of an adult guardian or parent of such child.

33. You shall not be in any public park, public swimming area, daycare centre, school ground, playground or community centre where one might reasonably expect children under the age of _____(16/18) years to be present.

34. You are not allowed to volunteer or work in any position that puts you in charge of or working with any person under the age of _____ (16/18) years.

35. You shall provide proper care and support for your dependant/dependants.

36. You shall immediately give to your probation officer any passport that has been issued to you by any country and you shall not apply for or renew a passport from any country.
