1. About This Release

In this Release 3.5, RCS incorporates changes to pre-booking rules and the booking of later dates (in Edmonton only).

The email confirmation message now prominently displays the name of the Accused in the header of the message.



2. New Features / Enhancements

2.1. Changes to Pre-Bookings Description Matters can now be booked in RCS until 3:30 p.m. on the business day before the next scheduled court appearance and the next scheduled court appearance is cancelled. Matters booked between 3:30 p.m. on the business day before and 8:00 a.m. on the day of the next court appearance are "pre-bookings" that require counsel to appear at the original next scheduled court appearance to confirm the booking. **Details** When a matter is a "pre-booking", counsel must confirm attendance at the original next scheduled court appearance on the Confirmation screen. Confirmation The next court appearance for any of the selected files/accused for this booking have a next appearance within the minimum time period required. Counsel/Accused is still required to appear at the next court date indicated for these files/accused to confirm this booking. Crown attendance is required to confirm date if next date is not located at the Case Management Office. The email Booking Confirmation reaffirms counsel's obligation to attend at the original next scheduled court appearance to confirm the booking.
